Amis Collection by Dorothy Hale, Amis, Mercer Island, collection and Elizabeth Steadman Owings, author Clinton, Mississippi

This Collection for the Amis book was compiled by Elizabeth Steadman Owings in the years 1992-1996. She had been collecting AMIS records from many family branches for more than thirty years. Her resulting book, *Amis and Related Families* was self published in 1996. The bound book has been cataloged into the Fiske Library, with a second copy filed into her collection.

Owings begins the story with the Louis Amis born in 1670 in Manakintown, Virginia, a third generation French Huguenot family and traces the family down in some lines as late as the 1990s. The indices are confusing as there are three separate indices, and one is in reverse order, but the page numbers seem correct so it is a helpful addition. The book contains 125 pages and the collection of three banker boxes of research materials, alpha filed by surname in Manila folders collected by Dorothy Amis.. Elizabeth Lynn Steadman's line descends from Mary Amis, who eloped with Joseph Rogers in 1786. Mary, born 22 August 1768, was third daughter of Thomas Amis and Alice GALE, he a member of the NC Legislature. This Thomas was grandson of Louis Amis, 1670.

Biography Elizabeth Lynn (Steadman) Owings

Elizabeth Lynn STEADMAN was born in Exeter, California on the 19 November, 1910. She attended the University of Knoxville, was a member of the Presbyterian Church where she served several terms as President of Women of the Church. She was also a member of the DAR; Magna Charta Dames, a family genealogist and a member of several genealogical societies. She married 21 August 1933 at Kingsport to Addison Davis OWINGS born 21 September 1907, son of Jesse Mercer and Edna Earl (Davis) Owings. He held a B.S. from the University of Southern Mississippi, 1928, an M.S. from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, 1931 and an M.S.P.H. Yale University, 1947. He was Director of School Health Services for the Mississippi Department of Education when he retired. (Owings, Elizabeth Lynn Steadman, *Amis and Related Families*, pp 55-57)
