

Mildred Eaton Collection

The Mildred Eaton Collection consists of 12 large archival storage boxes of information on the BAPTISTA and VIDETTA families of the Azores who came to Petaluma, California, and the Eatons of Maidenhead, England. Box 1 contained books that have been cataloged into the Fiske Collection. Box 2 is primarily wonderful family photographs, stored in boxes and albums. Additionally there are 6 folders with emphasis on the Baptista family

Biography:

Mildred Elizabeth BAPTISTA, OF Petaluma, California, born 12 May 1917, was daughter of Antone Baptista and Loretta Irene Newton married 30 May 1946 to Robert Desmond EATON born in Maidenhead, England, 10 September 1916, son of Robert Edward Harding EATON and Nina Fay FITZ GERALD. She was a caseworker, licensing day cares, and worked as a social worker in Seattle and Tacoma. Mildred taught PE and Hygiene at the American Academy for girls in Istanbul. Bob worked in maintenance for a restaurant chain, and worked 5 years as a business manager in Turkey.
