

Jacqueline CEDARHOLM Collection

The CEDARHOLM Collection consists of 3 boxes containing notebooks with information on various branches of Jacqueline's Swedish and Welsh family, including some of the following surnames: CEDARHOLM, COX, MORGAN, DAVIS, HOWELLS, EVANS, JAENSON, LARSDOTTER, BORIESDOTTER, MEYERS. She titled her notebooks which have been numbered by Fiske for accessibility, her work completed in 2011. The notebooks reflect her careful research, containing census records, both in the US Sweden and Wales, naturalization records, original death certificates, articles, maps and photos of this family. Records are placed in archival envelopes within the 1 inch binders. The Cedarholms, her father's Swedish family, came through Illinois to Spokane and Snohomish while her Mother's Welsh father, Morgan Morgans, son of William Morgan and Margaret HOWELLS, went first to Schuylkill Co. Pennsylvania, then Placer County California and then to Nortonville. They came to Black Diamond, WA in 1898 when the entire Nortonville mining operation moved to Black Diamond. Jacqueline's research is well organized and includes much original material. The materials may be useful to other Welsh researchers, even those with different family surnames.

Biography Jacqueline Cedarholm

Jacqueline Cedarholm was born 2 August 1923 in Roseville, Placer County California, daughter of Ralph Francis Cedarholm and Glen Morgan. Jackie's maternal grandparents were Morgan Morgan and Elizabeth Davies, the progenitors of this Welsh mining family collection. Morgan Morgans discovered famous Eureka gold claim in Sutter Creek, California where he became Superintendant, and then ran their California Black Diamond Coal Mines. He then became Superintendant of the mining operation when it and the community moved north to Washington in 1881.

The Morgans had three surviving daughters: Mary E. b 14 Oct 1877, married to Walter Davis; Olive, who married Merling E. Custer; and Glen who married Ralph F. Cedarholm, all of Seattle. The Cedarholms, Jackie's parents, were later divorced. Many of Morgan Morgans' tools and his mining equipment were donated to the Black Diamond Museum. Jackie was an only child who graduated from the University of Washington in Music, playing the violin and crwth (Welsh fiddle). She played with the Seattle Symphony, the Broadway Symphony, and the Seattle Philharmonic Orchestra. She taught music in the Seattle Public Schools for 34 years. Additionally she played the organ, teaching students to play theater organ. She was founder of the Ban Y Ddraig Goch, a Welch band.

At the time of her research, Jackie was living at 6720 Greenlake Way N, Seattle. The collection also reflects her paternal family, Peter Francis Cedarholm in Ringavarum, Ostergotlands, Sweden, and Mary Evangeline Cox of Iowa Falls, Storm Lake, Iowa. A pedigree chart for Jacqueline Cedarholm has been placed in the front of notebook 1.
