# **Description:**

The Euretta V. DeBoer SHIRLEY collection consisted of 9 boxes of books and journals that were integrated into the Fiske Library Collection, providing many copies to fill in existing series, and adding some southern journals that broadened the Library collection. She has also donated a number of books to the Fiske Library.

Additionally, she had two boxes of file folders, labeled by family sur-names, and areas of research that have been here merged and indexed. Her collection included research on both her own Dutch De BOER name and that of her husband, Burton Guy SHIRLEY. There are some wonderful original cartes de visite filed under the Martin family, though only a few are identified. Folders of "How to Do" information for general research for the beginning genealogist, are included in alpha order. For brevity, the collection is titled the SHIRLEY collection.

## **Biography:**

Euretta left a *My Family History* booklet, partially completed, that provided data for this biography, with assistance from on line sources including census and marriage records. Euretta Vanita DeBoer was born 24 October 1921 in Thomas County, Nebraska, daughter of Walter DeBoer born 1886 in Iowa, whose family was of Dutch ancestry from Holland and New York, and his wife, Ellen Marie Fredeen. Ellen was born 27 Sep 1889 at Loomis, Phelps County, Nebraska but her parents were born in Sweden and raised in that tradition. Ellen learned to speak English when she started school. The maternal grandfather was Gustaf Adolf Freideen. Euretta married 27 July 1940 in Payette County Idaho to Burton Guy Shirley who was born 7 December 1919, in Campbell, Hunt County, Texas, and died 6 April 1982 in Salem, Marion County, Oregon. The couple had three children. Her DeBoer family moved from Dismal, Nebraska in the 1920s, to Malheur, Oregon by 1940. His parents were Oliver Chester Shirley, born 24 March 1898, died 13 June 1971, in Sacramento, CA and Tisha Alma Hawkins, born 4 July 1893, died 12 October or November 1960. Euretta had begun a family tree that listed her siblings, all of whom were born in Thedford, Thomas Co. Nebraska, as follows:
