## **Description:**

The GIBBS Collection at the Fiske Library consists of two file drawers of accordion folders filled with manila folders alphabetically arranged by surname within each folder. One might suspect that the separate accordion files represent family lines, but they are not so labeled. Individual folders contain primarily a family group sheet, followed by photocopies of book and journal articles relevant to the individual surnames as well as some research notes. An attempt has been made to date and locate the family folders in ways that will serve as finding aids for future researchers.

The photo copies of articles have not been indexed at this time, but remain in the appropriate folder. The Gibbs collection does bring together many of the published articles relating to each of the surnames referenced.

## Biography:

Paul Claude GIBBS was born 18 December, 1926 in Hay Springs, Nebraska, son of George Robert Gibbs and Genevieve Mary Reece. Paul came to Seattle in 1931 where he attended Ravenna Elementary and Roosevelt High School. He graduated from the University of Washington in 1948 with a degree in Business and Accounting, and earned his law degree in 1952. He practiced with Moriarty and Olson.

Gibbs married 10 September 1948 to Dorothy G. MORGAN. As a young man Paul was quite an athlete, a boxer and squash player. He coached the Washington Athletic Club's boxers for the Golden Gloves. He unsuccessfully ran for the Legislature as a Republican in 1950. In 1952, Gibbs was appointed deputy prosecuting attorney to prosecutor, Charles O. Carroll. He worked for the Yakima School District in 1967.

Paul was very interested in his family history and during his final years, often spent much time at the Fiske Library. He died very suddenly of a heart attack on 11 July 1995, before he was able to produce a final genealogical product.
